Restrictions on Fires and Burning


Residents are reminded that burning cardboard and other waste in open fires is prohibited by Hamburg Twp ordinances (Sec 16-58, Ord. No. 40-F, § 6.0, 11-9-2017). These rules



are enforceable by the township, not the HOA. If practical, talk to your neighbor before contacting the township to report ordinance violations.

Additional Township Ordinances

Noise Restrictions





» Speakers/Amplifiers should not be plainly audible off property from 10pm –7am, or 100 ft beyond property line from 7am-10pm

Animal control

» Animals must be on a 6 foot (max) leash on public property (roads, sidewalks)



» Barking must not be audible beyond property at night, or beyond 100 ft away from property during the day

4th of July Fireworks Restrictions

» Fireworks are prohibited before 11am or after 11:45pm on June 29th-July 5th



» No Fireworks **before 11am or after 10pm** other days
